*After Michael D. gave the report the floor was opened to questions. A question was asked about the post office box for SWANA and who has access to it and whether or not it has been checked recently. Roxane (Convention Secretary) said that she has one of the keys and has checked the mailbox recently, and Michael D. said that he has a key as well. It was also said that the Area Secretary should have a key and access to the box but Rebecca said that it has not been given to her, nor is she aware of the location of the mailbox. The Journey Continues inquired as to whether a budget had been made for 2022 and if an audit had yet taken place or was planned. Secretary Report

January 2022

The minutes from the December 2021 ASC meeting were posted on the website and sent to home groups on Monday, December 27th, 2021. I sincerely apologize for the delay and not meeting the policy required 10 day deadline, as the Christmas holiday complicated things a bit. Going forward this should not be an issue. At the last area meeting there was an inquiry about the email addresses that had been set up by the Home Groups. I was unable to find the list by the previous secretary that had this information. In April 2017 there was a motion passed that indicated Home Groups should have a Gmail account (see page 90 of policy). I have been managing the Area Zoom accounts. Currently there are three home groups utilizing solely the Zoom platform, and one that is hybrid. If any groups would like to go hybrid or subcommittees would like to set up a meeting please contact me. It would be appreciated that the login information for the Area Zoom accounts is limited to only those who are chairing the meeting, as we have already had issues with outside individuals finding our zoom meeting IDs and passwords, posting them on social media, and “bombing” our meetings. For this reason an additional safety measure has been added to most of our meetings where the person that is chairing the meeting must “admit” people. I am also kindly asking individuals who are joining JAC and/or ASC to join using their personal email account and not one of the Area accounts. When using one of the Area accounts please do not change the photo or name, as it will show up that way for whomever uses it next.

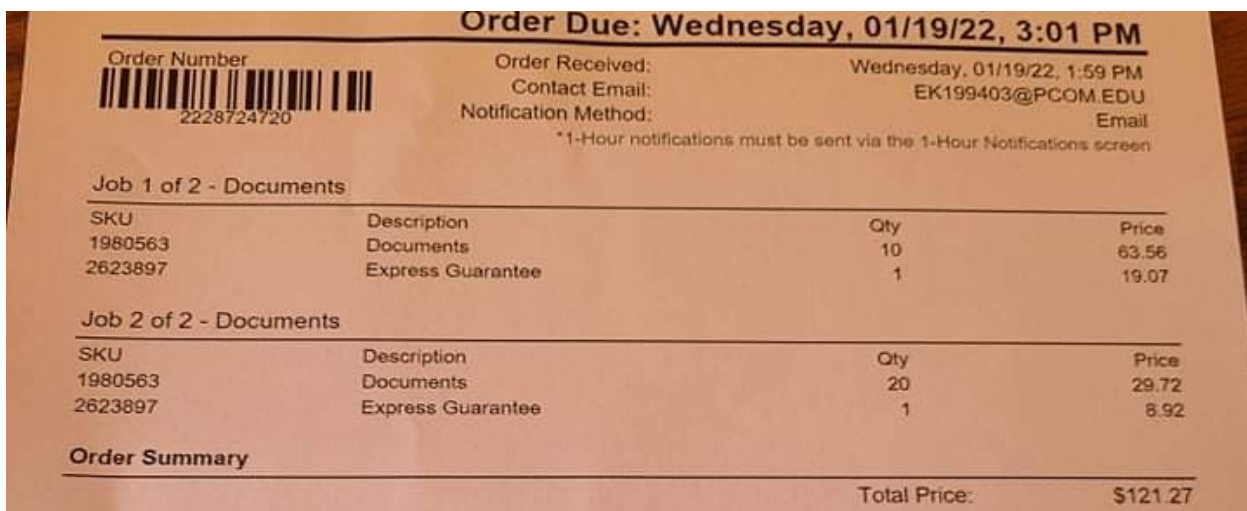
