#### **Secretary Report**

January 2022

The minutes from the December 2021 ASC meeting were posted on the website and sent to home groups on Monday, December 27<sup>th</sup>, 2021. I sincerely apologize for the delay and not meeting the policy required 10 day deadline, as the Christmas holiday complicated things a bit. Going forward this should not be an issue. At the last area meeting there was an inquiry about the email addresses that had been set up by the Home Groups. I was unable to find the list by the previous secretary that had this information. In April 2017 there was a motion passed that indicated Home Groups should have a Gmail account (see page 90 of policy). If Home Groups are unable to obtain the email information and password from previous GSRs it would be in the best interest of the group to set up a new email account through Gmail. If any home groups need assistance setting up a gmail account please contact me. Attached is a list of meetings for which there is absolutely no email information. If your home group is not on this list, a home group email has been established at some point and information has been sent to that email address. I have been managing the Area Zoom accounts. Currently there are three home groups utilizing solely the Zoom platform, and one that is hybrid. It would be greatly appreciated if the meeting that is doing hybrid could indicate whether or not they would like to continue using Zoom. There are at least five subcommittees, in addition to JAC and ASC that are meeting on Zoom as well. If any groups would like to go hybrid or subcommittees would like to set up a meeting please contact me. It would be appreciated that the login information for the Area Zoom accounts is limited to only those who are chairing the meeting, as we have already had issues with outside individuals finding our zoom meeting IDs and passwords, posting them on social media, and "bombing" our meetings. For this reason an additional safety measure has been added to most of our meetings where the person that is chairing the meeting must "admit" people. I am also kindly asking individuals who are joining JAC and/or ASC to join using their personal email account and not one of the Area accounts. When using one of the Area accounts please do not change the photo or name, as it will show up that way for whomever uses it next. After the last ASC meeting an issue was brought to light about voting on motions. Policy states that those who are in position as officers on the Area level must give up their role as GSR when they are elected (For further information please refer to page 21 of Policy, Article VI, Section VI-3: The Election Process, Section D, Bullet point 4). Once an individual is elected to an Area Officer position a new GSR must be found for the Home Group as soon as possible, otherwise the group will not be able to vote at Area.


