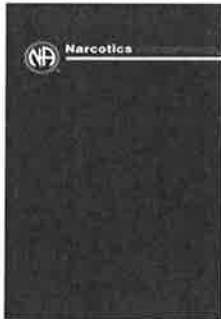

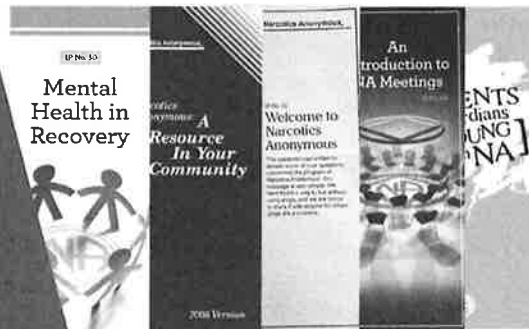

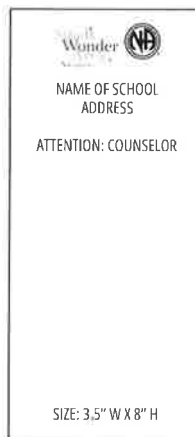

DAMAGE TO FUNCTION SPACE

Small Wonder Area Convention of Narcotics Anonymous agrees to pay for any damage to the function space that occurs while Small Wonder Area Convention of Narcotics Anonymous is using it. Small Wonder Area Convention of Narcotics Anonymous will not be responsible, however, for ordinary wear and tear or for damage that it can show was caused by persons other than Small Wonder Area Convention of Narcotics Anonymous and its attendees.

FACILITY FEES

Based on Small Wonder Area Convention of Narcotics Anonymous requirements, Hotel’s function space fees would be waived.

Attrition: Customer will meet its Adjusted Minimum Guest Room Revenue commitment based on the attrition allowance below.

Adjusted Minimum Guest Room Revenue:	80% of \$18,040 = \$14,432.00
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This attrition allowance does not apply if Customer cancels the Agreement or does not hold the event at Hotel. If Customer holds its event at Hotel, but does not fulfill its Adjusted Minimum Guest Room Revenue commitment it will pay Guest Room Attrition Damages (plus all applicable taxes) as a reasonable estimate of Hotel’s losses as follows:

Guest Room Attrition Damages = Adjusted Minimum Guest Room Revenue <i>minus</i> actual guest room revenue from Room Block
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Cancellation: If Customer cancels this Agreement, Customer will provide written notice to Hotel, accompanied (except in the case of a Force Majeure) by payment of the amounts indicated below:

From the Agreement Date to 61 days prior to 14-Dec-2018 :	25% of Total Minimum Revenue = \$3,608.00
From 60 days to 31 days prior to 14-Dec-2018:	50% of Total Minimum Revenue = \$7,216.00
From 30 days or less prior to 14-Dec-2018:	100% of Total Minimum Revenue = \$14,432.00

The parties agree that the amounts included in this Cancellation clause are reasonable estimates of the losses that would be incurred by Hotel and factor in Hotel's ability to mitigate its losses through resale.

Group may pay all or part of its obligation under this Agreement by credit card; provided that Group completes, signs and faxes back a credit card authorization form to 302.364.2003. If group invoice is not settled at checkout by the credit card below, the group shall be assessed a 3% handling fee. For invoices that are not settled within 30 days, a 2% finance charge shall be assessed.

Each room is required to place a credit card at check in to be authorized for room, tax, and \$50 per night of their reservation incidental guarantee.

Use of debit cards are discouraged as the system automatically takes an authorization upon the guest checking in. Any amount beyond the final confirmed charges at checkout is released upon the guest checking out of their room, however individual banks vary on their policy in regards to making those funds available to the account holder, taking anywhere from 3 to 7 business days.

Incidentals consist of, but are not limited to, room service, restaurant charges to the room, phone calls, pay per view movies and any other charges that may be placed to the room. The placement of the deposit also provides insurance of coverage for any damages caused by guests to guest rooms.

IMPOSSIBILITY

The performance of this Agreement is subject to termination without liability upon the occurrence of any circumstance beyond the control of either party – such as acts of God, war, acts of terrorism, government regulations, disaster, strikes, civil disorder, or curtailment of transportation facilities – to the extent that such circumstance makes it illegal or impossible for the Hotel to provide, or for groups in general to use, the Hotel facilities. The ability to terminate this Agreement without liability pursuant to this paragraph is conditioned upon delivery of written notice to the other party setting forth the basis for such termination as soon as reasonably practical - but in no event longer than ten (10) days - after learning of such basis.

COMPLIANCE WITH LAW

This Agreement is subject to all applicable federal, state, and local laws, including health and safety codes, alcoholic beverage control laws, disability laws, federal anti-terrorism laws and regulations, and the like. Hotel and Small Wonder Area Convention of Narcotics Anonymous agree to cooperate with each other to ensure compliance with such laws.

CHANGES, ADDITIONS, STIPULATIONS, OR LINING OUT

Any changes, additions, stipulations or deletions including corrective lining out by either Hotel or Small Wonder Area Convention of Narcotics Anonymous will not be considered agreed to or binding on the other unless such modifications have been initialed or otherwise approved in writing by the other.

DISPUTE RESOLUTION

In the event of dispute resolution, the non-prevailing party will pay the other's costs and attorney's fees.

LIQUOR LICENSE

Small Wonder Area Convention of Narcotics Anonymous understands that Hotel's liquor license requires that beverages only be dispensed by Hotel employees or bartenders. Alcoholic beverage service may be denied to those guests who appear to be intoxicated or are underage.

PRIVACY

Marriott International, Inc. ("Marriott") is committed to complying with obligations applicable to Marriott under applicable privacy and data protection laws, including to the extent applicable EU data protection laws. about its collection and use of their personal data, including through the Privacy Statement; (2) use such personal data only for legitimate business purposes; (3) provide means by which individuals may request to review, correct, update, suppress, restrict or delete or port their personal data, consistent with applicable law; (4) require any service providers with whom personal data is shared to protect the confidentiality and security of such data; and (5) use technical and organizational measures to protect personal data within its organization against unauthorized or unlawful access, acquisition, use, disclosure, loss, or alteration.

Small Wonder Area Convention of Narcotics Anonymous will obtain all necessary rights and permissions prior to providing any personal data to Hotel, including all rights and permissions required for Hotel, Hotel affiliates, and service providers to use and transfer the personal data to locations both within and outside the point of collection (including to the United States) in accordance with Hotel's privacy statement and applicable law. Notwithstanding any other provision, Hotel may use an individual's own personal data to the extent directed by, consented to or requested by such individual.

IN-HOUSE EQUIPMENT

Hotel will provide, at no charge, a reasonable amount of meeting equipment (for example, chairs, tables, chalkboards, etc.). These complimentary arrangements do not include special setups or extraordinary formats that would deplete Hotel's present in-house equipment to the point of requiring rental of an additional supply to accommodate Small Wonder Area Convention of Narcotics Anonymous's needs. If such special setups or extraordinary formats are requested, Hotel will present Small Wonder Area Convention of Narcotics Anonymous two (2) alternatives: (1) charging Small Wonder Area Convention of Narcotics Anonymous the rental cost for additional equipment, or (2) changing the extraordinary setup to a standard format, avoiding the additional cost.

UNATTENDED ITEMS/ADDITIONAL SECURITY

USE OF OUTSIDE VENDORS

If Small Wonder Area Convention of Narcotics Anonymous wishes to hire outside vendors to provide any goods or services at Hotel during the Event, Small Wonder Area Convention of Narcotics Anonymous must notify Hotel of the specific goods or services to be provided and provide sufficient advance notice to the Hotel so that the Hotel can (i) determine, in Hotel's sole discretion, whether such vendor must provide Hotel, in form and amount reasonably satisfactory to Hotel, an indemnification agreement and proof of adequate insurance, and (ii) approve, using reasonable judgment, the selection of the outside vendor and the goods or services to be provided by such outside vendor to Small Wonder Area Convention of Narcotics Anonymous, taking into consideration: (a) whether Hotel offers such goods and services; (b) the risk level posed by certain activities; and (c) the safety and well-being of guests at Hotel.

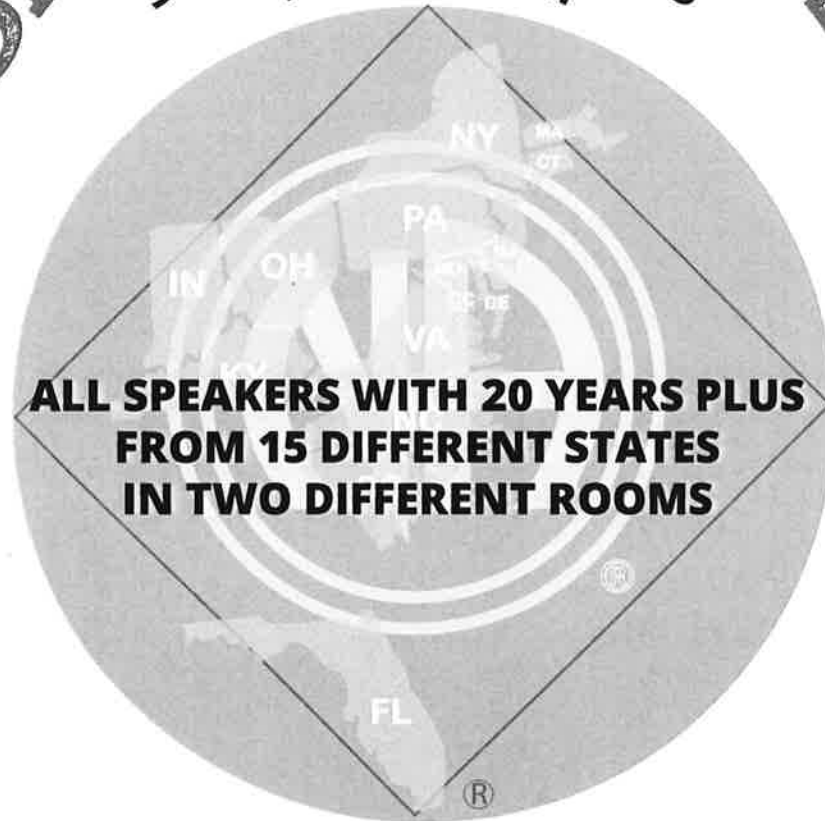
