

As our convention approaches the six-month mark, we continue to search for venue options that will allow our committee to host fundraising events. The cost and schedule seem to be our biggest hurdle in exploring new facilities. As we attempt to address the concern of so few events in the suburbs and too many events in the city, we find that the events we try to put on in the suburbs site lose money. Excluding the events, we hold at St. James Church. Another issue is that the Executive Body does not have a relationship with the decision-makers at some of these facilities and therefore can't get in the door. Then other facilities and administrators are open to us utilizing their facilities. Our challenge in these situations has been either the dates we want are not available or the cost is beyond what we can afford to pay because of other expenses and dwindling bank account. We have sold over 300 reservations. Most have been purchased by members in our area. Thank you for your support. Things have changed with convention committees being able to set up and sell registration in other areas. These types of fundraising efforts are being frowned upon. Some areas feeling funds and resources are being depleted from their areas.

Our treasure is scratching his head in a worrisome manner, concerned with being able to replenish the funds our area has entrusted us with. Our next events are slotted for November 16th November 30th December 14th & December 28th venue update to follow. As the Chair of the Convention, I am pleading with the area for your support and participation. We need the inner-city groups and the suburban groups to come out to support our events. Please invite your friends from Small Wonder and other areas, and purchase food and merchandise to help raise the needed funds so we are not a burden to the areas' finances.

I think we can overcome our financial challenges and to make our convention a success. Our goal is to create funds to help the area and supply startup funds for our next convention committee. Our venues and locations may not appeal to everyone; however, they are our most cost-effective locations available. Your contribution of time and presence will allow the newcomer to experience a Small Wonder Area Convention. With your continued support and utmost understanding. We can bring as we always have the first tradition passage to life "set aside our differences to show the newcomer how it works".
