I brought several copies back to the area. Trisha is also focusing on the IDT's (Issue Discussion Topics), especially DRT/MAT (Drug Replacement Therapy) and (Medically Assisted Treatment). The Free State Region will be sending our RD and RDA to the next Multi-Zonal Symposium in November. Total cost will be \$816.45. The next Zonal Zoom Webinar hosted by free state region is 7 p.m. on Sept.17<sup>th</sup> and November 19<sup>th</sup>. Anyone can listen in but you cannot partake in it's conversation. 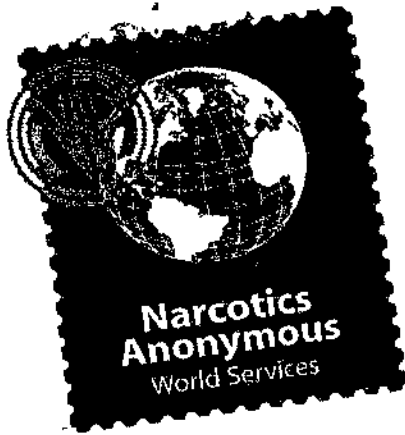
