As you may know the subcommittee of Unity and Activities is in desperate need of trusted servants willing to be in service. There were zero members in attendance at our last subcommittee meeting which was held on 01/20/2020. I have signed a contract with First Alliance Church in regards to the upcoming event that will be held at their facility on Saturday March 21st from 1pm to 8pm. The rent for the event will be a onetime fee of \$100. The facility has also asked that we write a separate check of \$50 as a security deposit for the event which will be returned to us after the event is complete if of course there is not damage to their property.

I would also like to apologize to the area for my frustration at last month's area service. I have found that this service commitment is very hard to fulfill without the support that is needed. The area had asked me last month to write a detailed estimate in regards to the funds needed for the upcoming event on March 21st. The estimate is as follows, \$100 for rent to the facility, \$150 for drinks such as water, coffee, soda, ice, creamer, and sweetener. \$250 for food, which will hopefully consist of different dishes from different cultures in order to go with the theme of our event. There will also be deserts and snacks. \$50 for paper products such as table cloths, napkins, cups, plates and utensils. This comes to a total of \$550 a motion was put in place at last month's area service that since there will only be one event for the month of march that Unity and Activities be allowed to use an additional \$200 for the event making the budget for one event 600\$ opposed to the \$800/month approved budget for two events.

It was brought to my attention that this year's annual anniversary picnic was booked for Saturday July 18th 2020. I regret to inform you that I will not be available to be in service for this event as I will be away on my honey moon as I am getting married 2 days prior. I did not book this event and as of current standing I am the only active member of Unity and Activities so I am calling upon the area in order to make this event possible as it is an event that I am aware the area looks forward to every year.

I am aware that when I took on this commitment that the service term was 1 year however I was not aware that I would not have a subcommittee to help me through events. If I cannot get a subcommittee formed by the next event which is scheduled for March 21st I will have to step down as Unity and Activities Chair. I want to thank the area for intrusting me with this service commitment however taking on such a big commitment by myself has had a detrimental effect on my physical health. Although this service commitment has helped me improve in some areas it has also had a negative effect on my home life and personal recovery. As we are all aware that our personal recovery depends on NA unity I have come to the conclusion that I cannot fulfill my service commitment to the best of my ability. 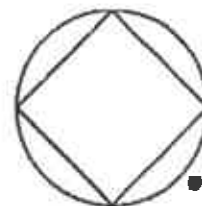
