Old Business:

Previous meeting minutes accepted.

Reports:

- **Chair Report – (verbal)** Last ASC meeting went well. Meeting held with Chase Center to discuss final needs for the event. Costs will be reviewed by the Treasurer.
 - Questions/Discussion: None
- **Treasurer's Report (attached)** Need to meet an 18k food purchase minimum. Could be up to 5k short if we don't sell all food tickets. Chase Center agreed to add items to the kiosk to sell towards our food purchase minimums.
 - Question:
 - Could everyone promote the full registration packages and our next F&E event in meetings?
- **Subcommittee Reports:**

- **Registration (attached):** Program was sent to vendor to begin packaging. The Committee needs the number of newcomer packages to give out each day of the event. The Chair would like to have 2 cash registers and 2 lines at the event; 1 for those who have already registered, and another for new registrations. Request made to have a sign for registration and to distinguish lines.
 - Questions/Discussion:
 - Newcomer donations collected to date is approximately \$2600, per the Treasurer.
 - The cost for each newcomer registration will be \$20. That will allow 130 free packages to be given out.
 - Programming needs to add a few changes prior to packaging by vendor.
 - We have 2 cash registers in storage that can be used by the registration committee.

- **H&H (verbal):** Block rate ended 2/7/24. 92 rooms reserved. The 15 rooms added by the Chair were removed. 2 rooms left for staff. It can possibly be used for storage. Raffle for TV went well and made more than spent for the TV.
 - Questions/Discussion:
 - Do we have a room for marathon meetings in the Weston?
 - The Chair will follow up.
 - Can we use a room at the Chase Center?
 - No. We would have to rent a room at the Chase Center.
 - Registration committee needs a room on Thursday for pre-registration packing.
 - How many rooms left that we are obligated to?
 - 10 for each night for a total of 20.

- **F&E Report (verbal):** DJ contract signed for \$1200. Confirmed 3 comedians for \$1000. The photographer is confirmed for 25% of proceeds. Photographer needs jpeg for backdrop. Convention Chair will send a copy of contract to Secretary and F&E Chair.
 - Question:
 - Copies of contracts are needed ASAP.
 - F&E Chair will submit fund requests for contracts.
 - F&E chair will follow up with other vendors for photography and report back to committee.
 - We cannot finalize a contract without 3 bids. How was the photographer accepted and no other bids were reviewed? This makes the committee's integrity questionable.
 - Other photographer options did not contact the F&E Chair to consider prior to making a decision.

- **A&G (attached):** Banner is completed. Chair has 3 pieces for the silent auction. Color coded tickets were created for convention events. Assisting with Convention information vacancy. Chair needs information for signs/easels for the event. Chair needs treasure chest for donations. Donations needed by 2/24/24.
 - Questions/Discussion:
 - Saturday brunch can only be open for 2 hours. It will be from 11am-1pm in Christina ballroom. Sunday spiritual breakfast will be 8-10am in Christina ballroom.
 - How many tickets needed?

- 150 for brunch
- 100 for breakfast.
- 100 for comedy show
- 100 for dance - green armbands will be used for the Saturday dance.
- Where does the Chair purchase a treasure chest from?
 - Arts and crafts store
- How do we decide who wins the treasure chest?
 - Raffle is used.
- **Programming (verbal):** Format for the Friday opening meeting and Saturday main meeting reviewed (attached). Duffy is doing the area history. We need 30 people to chair meetings at the event.
 - Questions/Discussion:
 - Is there a minimum clean time requirement for chairing the meetings?
 - Yes. 2 yrs., and prior service experience.
 - Suggestion to ask SWANA Home Groups to assist with obtaining chairs for meetings.
 - How many breakout rooms are needed?
 - 5
- **Operations (attached):**
 - Questions/Discussion: None
- **Merchandise (verbal):** There is some pre-convention merchandise remaining to sell. Inventory will be completed at another time. The Chair plans to purchase 150 long sleeve t-shirts to sell at the event. Waiting for proposals from 4 vendors who wish to sell merchandise at the event.
 - Questions/Discussion: None

SWACNA XV Treasurer's Report

February 10, 2024

SWACNA XV's beginning balance on January 1st, 2023, was \$7,723.17. Our reconciled checking account balance as of January 31, 2023, was \$9,794.39. We've had registrations come in since then, making our current balance \$10,042.29.

Our last speaker jam brought in gross proceeds of \$2,791.63. Our expenses were \$738.00, giving us net proceeds of \$2,053.63. This was a hugely successful event for us!

Cheryl, Craig, Andre, and I met with Event Manager at the Chase Center on Thursday, 2/8/24. We went through the full event schedule and all the costs associated with our contract. We need to meet an \$18,000 food and beverage minimum, meaning we need to sell enough brunch and breakfast tickets and have enough coffee out to meet that minimum. My estimate is that we could be up to \$5,000 short if we don't sell all the brunch and the spiritual breakfast tickets. It's really important that every one of us encourages people to buy those tickets or to upgrade their registration to a full package.

We've asked that coffee is out at all times, which will help with the minimum, but we're awaiting a quote for bulk coffee before we know whether it's better to purchase the coffee by the pot, which is 3 gallons and costs \$180 or buy in bulk.

We discussed if there was anything we could do to meet the minimum, such as if they ever gave a percentage of the sales from the kiosk - he said no. By contract, we are not permitted to bring in and sell our own food. We also asked about whether they had menu items we could add to the kiosk for them to sell that could go toward our minimum. He said they normally don't do that, but that he would consider it for us. So, we're also waiting to hear from him on that.

He also said he was going to try to work on lowering the costs of the set up/breakdown porters, which cost \$1,600 last event. We can also use a private security company rather than the police; the private service is less expensive.

Without the full costs from the Convention Center, it's hard to accurately estimate what we'll owe going into the convention. We said from the beginning this event will likely cost us around \$32,000. We've paid the Convention Center \$20,000 and have over \$10,000 in the bank along with one more speaker jam. Let's make some money this month and keep pushing those full packages!

SWACNA XV Treasurer's Report

February 21, 2024

SWACNA XV's beginning balance on January 1st, 2023, was \$7,723.17. Our reconciled checking account balance as of January 31, 2023, was \$9,794.39.

Our January speaker jam brought in gross proceeds of \$2,791.63. Our expenses were \$738.00, giving us net proceeds of \$2,053.63.

Our February speaker jam brought in gross proceeds of \$2906.23. Our expenses were \$592.91 giving us net proceeds of \$2,313.32. These were both highly successful events for us and a great way to close out our fundraising events.

The Convention Chair, Co-Treasurer, F&E Chair, and I met with General Manager at the Chase Center on Thursday, 2/8/24. We went through the full event schedule and all the costs associated with our contract. They are helping us to meet the food and beverage minimum with their kiosk sales and are discounting several of their costs for us.

The full, estimated cost given to us by the General Manager is \$30,823. We've paid \$20,000 of that and have another \$5,000 set aside in our bank account, after all other expenses, to put toward the balance. This means that we should walk into the Convention owing just \$5,823 – which we should easily make during the Convention weekend. Given that we started fundraising four months late and had some bumps along the way, I'm pleased to be in such a strong financial position going into the Convention. Thank you for your support.

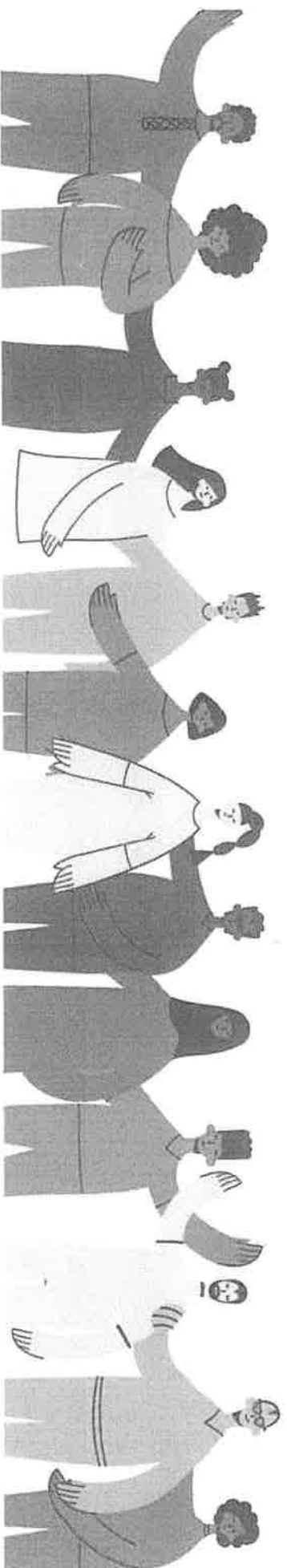

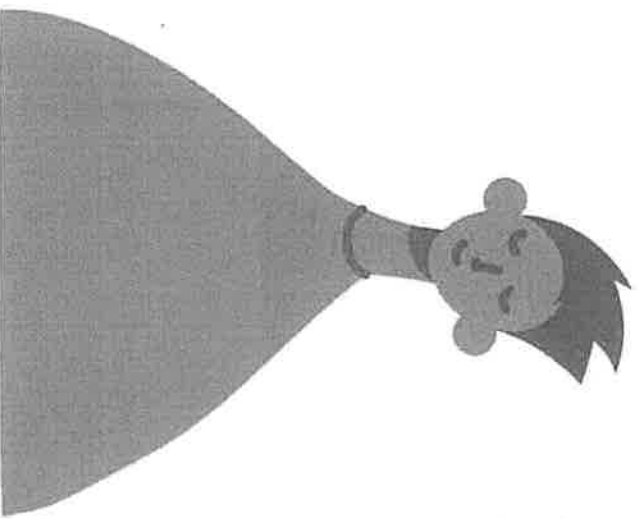

Gender Neutral and Inclusive Language in NA Literature



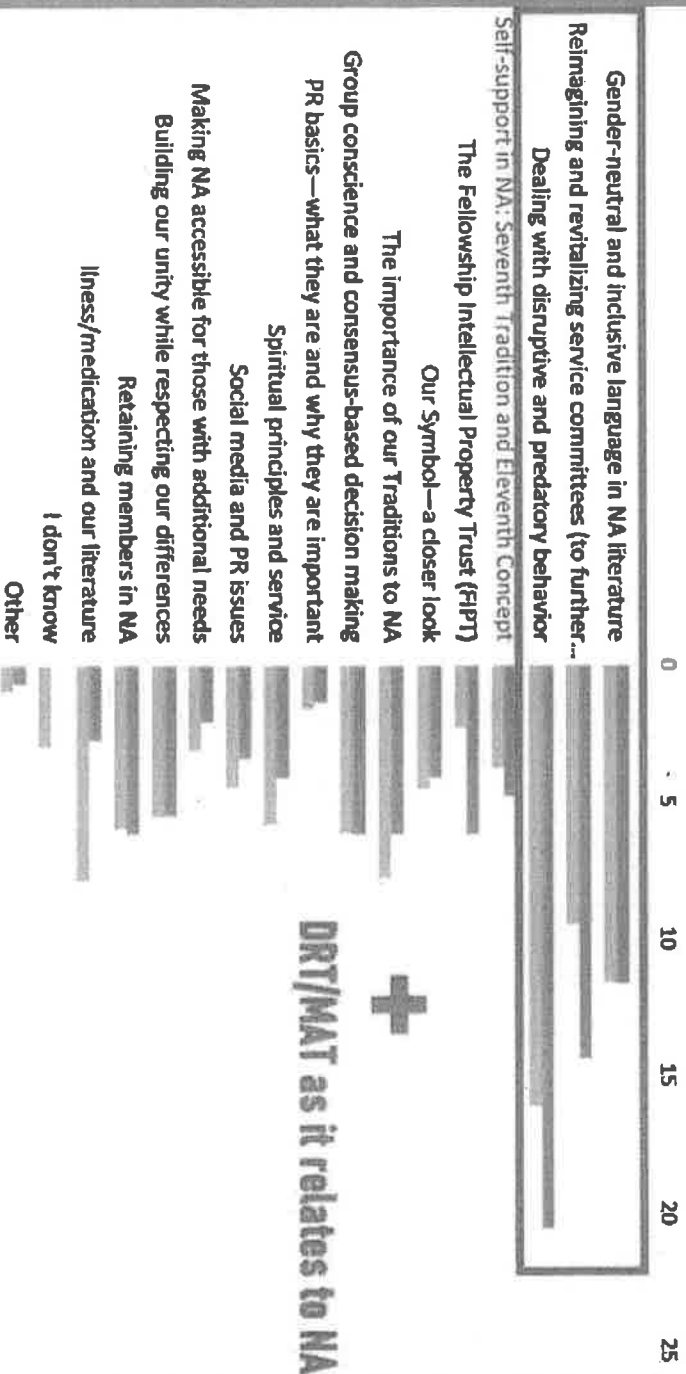

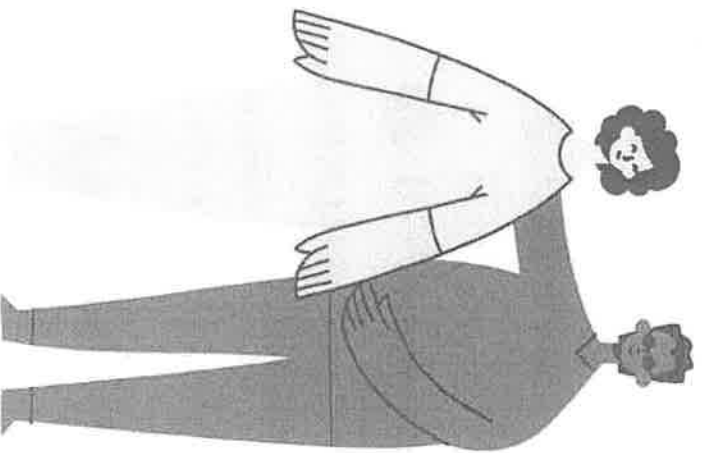

SWACNA XV Treasurer's Report

February 21, 2024

SWACNA XV's beginning balance on January 1st, 2023, was \$7,723.17. Our reconciled checking account balance as of January 31, 2023, was \$9,794.39.

Our January speaker jam brought in gross proceeds of \$2,791.63. Our expenses were \$738.00, giving us net proceeds of \$2,053.63.

Our February speaker jam brought in gross proceeds of \$2,906.23. Our expenses were \$592.91 giving us net proceeds of \$2,313.32. These were both highly successful events for us and a great way to close out our fundraising events.

The Convention Chair, Co-Treasurer, F&E Chair, and I met with General Manager at the Chase Center on Thursday, 2/8/24. We went through the full event schedule and all the costs associated with our contract. They are helping us to meet the food and beverage minimum with their kiosk sales and are discounting several of their costs for us.

The full, estimated cost given to us by the General Manager is \$30,823. We've paid \$20,000 of that and have another \$5,000 set aside in our bank account, after all other expenses, to put toward the balance. This means that we should walk into the Convention owing just \$5,823 – which we should easily make during the Convention weekend. Given that we started fundraising four months late and had some bumps along the way, I'm pleased to be in such a strong financial position going into the Convention. Thank you for your support.
