

Subcommittee Update:

The subcommittee met on Wed, September 6. Five members attended. Extensive discussion was held on the election process, specifically sub-section C. How the Election Process Works (p.21) The focus of the discussion was on removing any potential for confusion or ambiguity, and on improving the clarity and efficiency of the language guiding ASC officers during the June ASC meeting, which is devoted to Elections, as well as at other times when elections occur. Based on the feedback received during that conversation, a draft is being prepared to reflect consensus of subcommittee members on specific language in that section of ASC Policy, to be considered at our next meeting, Oct. 4th.

The subcommittee is also going to consider the possibility of amendments to ASC Policy on position requirements for officers and subcommittee chairs with regard to end-of-term transition to newly-elected trusted services. The aim of these discussions will be to strengthen or improve the preparation of new officers / subcommittee chairs to assume all aspects of their new roles in service to the Small Wonder groups.

Work will continue on procedural issues such as reformatting the Policy, Printing processes, semantic improvement to one small section of the Motions section of ASC Policy, establishment of Guidelines for the Policy subcommittee and assistance for

On September 9, 2023 we had our monthly convention body meeting, all went well, got a new H&H Chair and Co-Chair so, most positions are filled. Everything has been going good with what committee members we do have as everyone is pitching where needed.

The hotel contract has been signed, people can go to a link (Book your group rate for SWACNA-STAFF) for hotel rooms.

Our last speaker jam held on 09/16 was a success and the next one will be on October 21st. After the October speaker jam, we will move back to St. James Church in Newport/Stanton area because the accommodations for cooking is much better.

From November to February, we will continue having speaker jams to generate funds for our upcoming convention, we still have merchandise for sale and registration is now \$25 up until December 31st , then \$35 up until convention. Registration has bids for the packages and waiting for logo from A&G. There is currently 477 people registered for the upcoming convention.

 - Will we continue to get totals from treasurer/co-treasurer at the end of each event?
 - Yes. Totals will continue at the end of each event.
- **Subcommittee Reports:**
 - **Registration** (will email a copy) Current registration cost is \$25pp up to December 2023; then \$35pp. Bids obtained for registration package. Looking at adjustments to bring down costs.
 - Questions/Discussion:
 - Will 700 packages be enough to cover the ppl who may register at the convention?
 - Those who register at the convention will only get a lanyard.
 - Do we know the number of registration packages purchased in past conventions?
 - The committee doesn't receive the number of registration packages purchased.
 - Is the theme needed by the committee before you can start the package?
 - No. The theme is not needed. The committee currently uses the approved treasures of life for SWACNA.
 - The treasurer would like to assist with selling registration packages.
 - Will need to obtain contact information for each package sold to provide back to registration chair/committee.
 - The committee is considering lowering the registration package price from 130pp to 120-125pp to increase sales.
 - F&E Co-Chair agreed to \$120pp
 - Information will be updated by treasurer on SWACNA XV website and flyers.
 - Will there be a pre-registration option for the next convention?
 - No. Not an option for SWANA area.
 - Committee needs the Secretary to check the PO Box for any possible registration correspondence.
 - **Operations** (Attached)
 - Questions/Discussion:
 - Additional volunteers available and willing to assist with set up/break down at F&E events. Chair will put a flyer out and schedule a committee meeting.
 - Can the committee meet via zoom?
 - Chair requested technical assistance so that zoom option will be available to cut costs?
 - **F&E Report:** (Co-Chair - verbal)
 - Questions/Discussion:
 - Last speaker jam - problems with food and complaints that the food was cooked too hard; ran out of supplies, facility was dirty, and lack of communication.
 - Co-Chair needs square to collect funds in the kitchen.
 - Dance tickets – have any been sold? No tickets sold.

- Suggestion to sell tickets at the door for \$5.
- Suggestion to cancel the dance.
- DJ cost is \$150 for 2 events.
- Discrepancy in receipts and supplies. Should be addressed in treasurer's report.
- The treasurer did not notice a discrepancy, but found we purchased more fish than needed or sold.
- There is possibly a case of fish left to be sold at next event.
 - Leftovers – can we use to sale (sodas, chips, coffees, etc.)
- Are we getting another inventory to avoid overspending?
 - The treasurer and Co-Treasurer will collaborate with F&E chair to cut costs.
- **Programming:** (attached) Committee needs to know the number of tables and facility needs for the event to provide to the taping committee.
 - F&E has to ask the DJ what is needed.
 - Merchandise needs to provide the number of tables needed.
 - There will not be time to obtain additional tables at the day/time of the event.

SWACNA XV's beginning balance on August 1st, 2023, was \$5,422.26.

Our reconciled checking account balance as of August 31, 2023, was \$6,252.46. Our current balance is \$5004.66.

To date, we have paid the Chase Center \$20,000, which fulfills our commitment to the catering contract deposit. We will continue to make payments up until the convention as we anticipate additional costs for expenses such as audio/visual needs, required EMS and police services, coffee, and food station attendants, etc.

Our September speaker jam this past weekend was extremely successful. We grossed \$3955.46 and after expenses of \$840.92, netted \$3,114.54.
