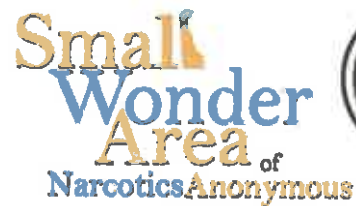


Area Service Committee

Meeting Minutes

Date: November 17, 2019



A. Opening of Meeting:

Meeting was called to order and opened with the Serenity Prayer at 430pm. The 12 Traditions and 12 Concepts were read by two participants present at the meeting.

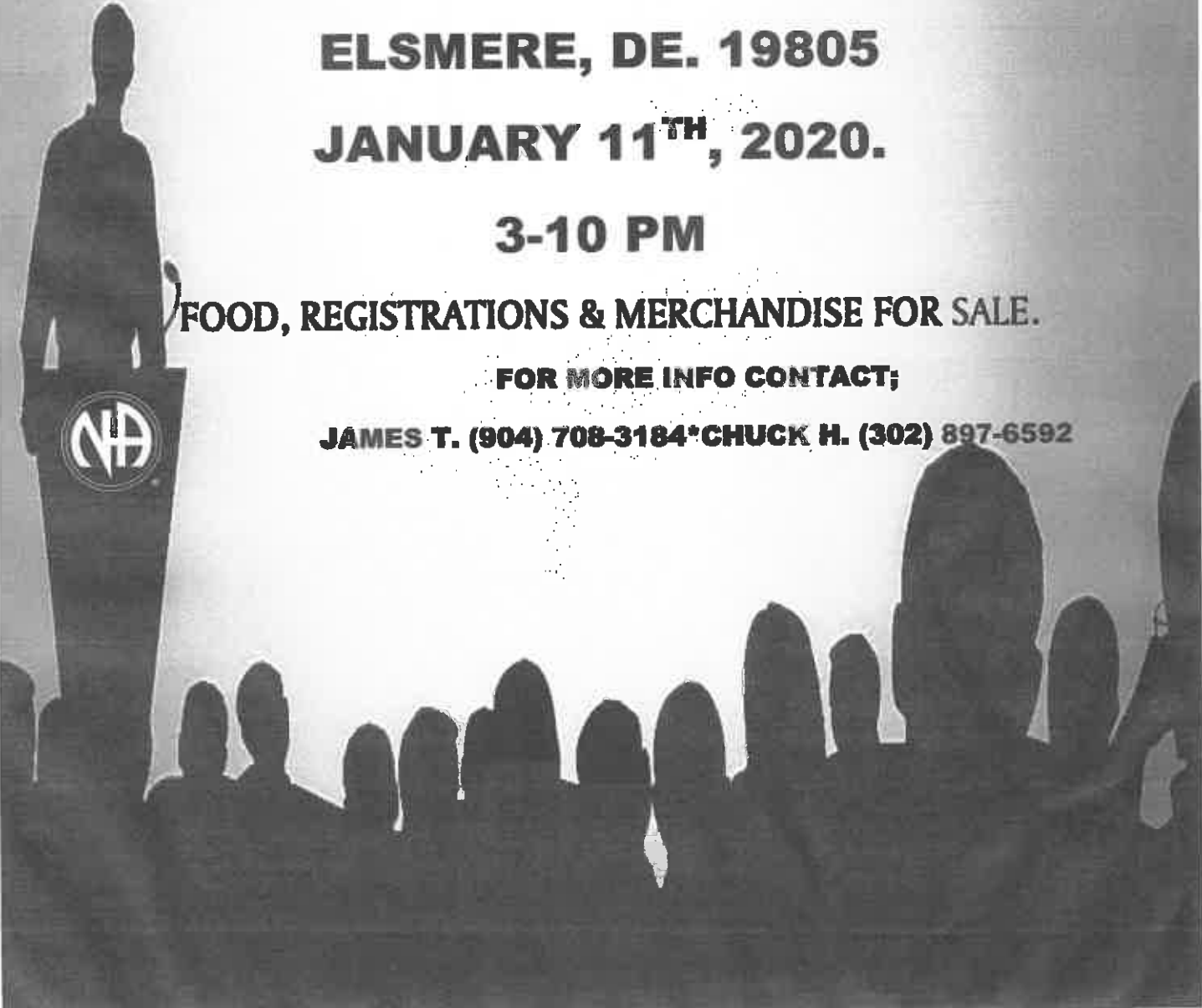
