Policy subcommittee is running well. We are pleased to report that the working document - - the Policy - has been successfully formatted into google docs, thanks to the diligent work of subcommittee member Roxane B. This means we will now be able to print, update, and interpret the Policy in the most effective and efficient manner. Our meeting was held on Nov. 1st, the 1st Wed of the month. - 3) Continuing review of different aspects of the election process, especially the existing language regarding filling vacancies at times other than the annual meeting in June.
- 4) Initiating discussions on how the Area may be able to improve the transition from outgoing to incoming officers and subcommittee Chairs, especially providing for overlaps in terms of service such as exist for the Convention committee.



SWACNA XV Treasurer's Report

November 11, 2023

SWACNA XV's beginning balance on October 1st, 2023, was \$4,815.05. Our reconciled checking account balance as of October 31, 2023, was \$7,312.36.

Our last speaker jam brought in gross proceeds of \$4,526.82. Our expenses were \$1,770.09, giving us net proceeds of \$2,756.73.

When I reported higher proceeds, it was due to a calculation error on my Income & Expenses spreadsheet. I put all income on one side, all expenses on the other, regardless of how cash is counted at the event. The spreadsheet calculation range didn't include the line with the cost of the comedians; when I realized that, I corrected the error. No cash was mishandled, and the total amount of cash counted at the event, \$3,060, is the amount that was deposited in the bank.

The chairs of Programming and Hotels & Hospitality have given me the information needed to reserve rooms for all the convention speakers. We are also paying for a basic registration for each and on Sunday, breakfast for the Sunday speaker. The approximate total cost for all of this is \$1,025. I will be paying for the room reservations on our credit card and will need to meet each speaker when they check-in; speakers will then need to use their credit card at that time for incidentals.

As we come down to our last four events, I've asked the Chair to set up a meeting with Chase Center so we can get final costs on the services we'll need beyond food and drinks.

SWANA POLICY Subcommittee GUIDELINES 11/01/2023

I. Purpose

- To maintain ASC Policy (hereafter: "Policy"), complete and current in all forms: Paper copies provided to Groups, electronic document and on the SWANA website.
- To incorporate any changes resulting from motions passed at Area into the Policy.
- To provide leadership in considering changes to the Policy which would improve Clarity, Efficiency and Usefulness in guiding the ASC in providing services to the groups, and by extension, to the addict who is seeking recovery.

II. Membership

Any member of the Small Wonder Area of NA is eligible to be a member of the Policy subcommittee, with voting privileges.

III Officers and Elections

- Chair: elected by the Groups at ASCM. Responsible for the functions of the subcommittee, for monthly meetings, and for representing the work of the subcommittee to the Area, as specified in Area Policy.

- Co-chair: elected by simple majority vote at Policy subcommittee. Stands in for chair if needed. Assists with decision-making and effective communication.

- Secretary: Takes minutes to provide continuity, per subcommittee meeting format. Keeps a record of decisions made in the subcommittee.

IV. Meetings

- Meetings will be held monthly, in person and on Zoom, for up to two hours. Discussion and debate will be guided by the 12 Concepts, especially Concepts 6 through 9.
- Meetings will follow the established format, qv (which see)

- Decisions will be reached through the process of Group Conscience (Concept 6), consensus, and if necessary, Voting. All members bear responsibility for the subcommittee's decisions. (Concept 9)
- Any proposal to change any part of the Area Policy agreed upon in the subcommittee will be submitted to the Groups at ASCM, clearly outlining the existing language ("FROM:"), followed by the proposed changes to that language (TO:)"
- In addition, the subcommittee will review guidelines submitted by the Area subcommittees, per Policy, as well as any other functions specified in the Policy.

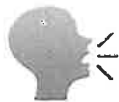

Rationale: From Concept 4: "Leadership qualities should be carefully considered when selecting trusted servants", and from A GUIDE TO LOCAL SERVICES IN NA, p. 46: "Area Service Committees are ultimately responsible to the Groups they serve."

Very simply, to place someone in a trusted servant position whom a majority of the Groups have said "no" to, would not be of service, and would disregard the opinion of the groups, with regard to Concept 4. It may not ever happen, but we have come close, and the Policy should be clear and consistent with the principles we are guided by.
