 - Barbara Jean: looked over motion, deemed it needs to be amended to include the body will stay on and only applies to SWACNA XVI

 - Pam: When will the current term end?
 - Barbara Jean: Will stay on until May 2027 to do a warm handoff to the next convention body. Nominations will start in January 2027
 - Chris reminded them to make sure the current body puts a hold for the following convention
 - Ian: Looked at Policy and doesn’t see that officers for convention nominations should be in January
 - Jess: Encouraged GSRs to bring motion to the floor
 - Mary: Amended the motion to include SWACNA XVI and that servants will stay on
- Jena (3 Minutes of Meditation) made motion: to change nomination dates for convention body officers to start in January

Subcommittee met February 16, 2025 via zoom from 7- 8:30pm
We discussed area minutes and the motions that occurred over the past 2 months . Policy committee was concerned with what had transpired. The motion that was passed in December used the word "hold" and was understood by the Policy Chair to be used for a possible date of the convention. After the last area service meeting and the report from the Convention Committee stating that they are still working on a contract. What is a Point Of Order? A Point of Order refers to a motion that calls attention to a potential breach of the rules of procedure. The Chair of the Group has to rule on whether the point is valid -Does not need/require to be 2nd- decided by chair without debate - unless the ruling is appealed by GSRs.

The Policy Committee hopes that all members of selfless service-GSRs and Convention Body, are able to come to a consensus/agreement on when and where the next convention will be held.

The Policy Committee does not create the guidelines and procedures, we work as a committee to support/understand all members and their concerns.


