The convention body is looking at venues to host our fundraising efforts. Those we used in the past and new venue possibilities:

The body being cognizant of our budget is focused on what it will cost us to hold events at chosen facilities. Facilities that would meet our fundraising needs. Such as use of kitchen and large meeting space. Keep in mind that we are putting forth the effort to create something that will raise funds as

well as events in the spirit of SWACNA XVI convention. We are an all-inclusive convention committee. This is not something that has been edge in stone. We will be following up with more detail at later date. Looking at things in perspective are us being able to at least have 4 events per venue.

If your homegroup has a kitchen and large meeting space and are open to us having an event in its facility reach out to the convention body committee. We are looking to start our fundraising efforts as soon as possible. We are hoping to be utilizing our website to post events as a means to get the word out.
