I want to apologize for missing last month's meeting. My step daughter graduated from the University of South Carolina on that day. I totally forgot it was the same day as region. Extra apologies to Mike and Arielle for missing the workgroup. I'm glad you had a pretty good turnout!

We had a zonal zoom meeting on May 20th at 7 pm. Greater Philadelphia is hosting the zonal forum meeting this time and they are having a 2 day event as we did in January. All are invited and encouraged to attend! The format is going to be the same as we had here with workshops during the day on Saturday, a main speaker at 7pm and a free hypnotist event that evening. On Sunday we will have the business meeting.

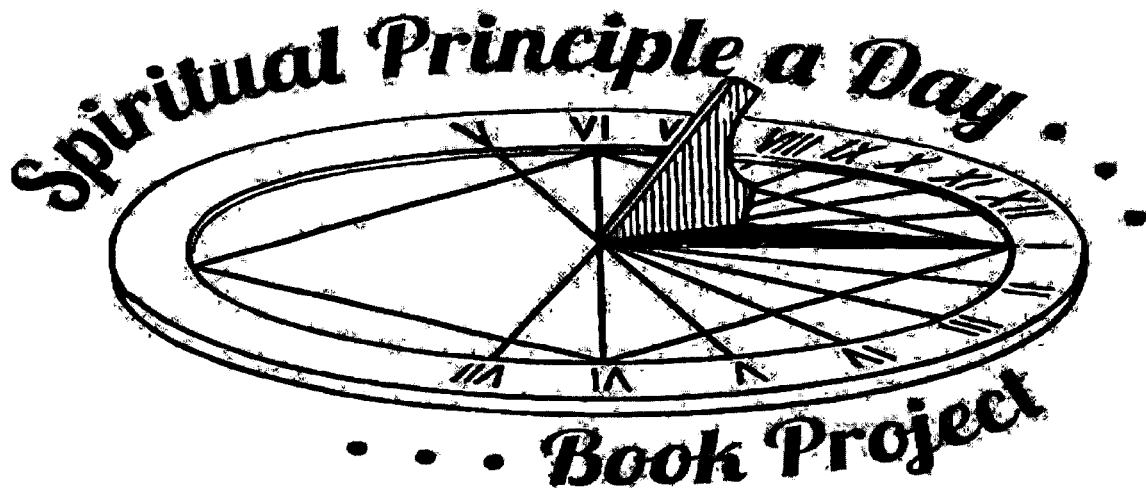

- Saturday Night Serenity has been added back onto our ~~website~~ *meeting list*
- The Each One Teach One Group's location has been changed to Connection's Community Church. This group's format has also been updated to include Handicap Friendly.
- 1,500 meeting lists were ordered and picked up from academy printing. The cost was \$140.10 and this was paid for by the Area.

The Website has been updated in the following ways:

- The above changes to our meeting list are also reflected on our website
- Events and flyers have been added to the area and regional website
 - Please note that this does not include the Area picnic as I do not have a flyer or enough information about this event to make a post. If anyone is involved with the planning of this event, please see me after the meeting so I can get this information from you and add the event.
- There was an error on the "More" tab of our website. Some of the text on this tab was white and was invisible because the background was white as well. I changed the format on this page and all the text is now visible.

The BMLT has been updated in the following ways:

- I finished going through the BMLT meeting by meeting and ensuring that the information reflected here is updated and accurate. At this point, all the information that region has should reflect exactly the current information on our paper list.
- Almost every group required at least some form of updates. Most of the meetings did not have the proper format listed and all our meetings were listed as being 1 hour long. I have corrected these errors.
- Some meetings required bigger changes than the duration and format of the meeting. There were meetings listed that haven't met in a very long time. There were also meetings that currently meet that were not listed at all.
- In theory, the information on the regional website should be updated already and the information that shows up on the NA World App should reflect these changes within one month

I received an e-mail from Michael C., our regional website coordinator. Michael requested that I e-mail region an excel sheet that details any changes I make on the BMLT. He explained that this excel sheet would be used to update region's paper meeting lists that are distributed at the Regional Service Meeting.

I told him that I'd be happy to do so and I did construct an excel sheet, recorded all the changes that I made, and provided it to region.

I have printed a copy of this spreadsheet to include in my report. With this sheet, groups will be able to see the information that was changed. I included an explanation of the change I made. Any changes that were made are written in gold text. Any information that I did not change is in black text. Please have a look at this list and ensure that the information on here is accurate so that if I made any errors, I can fix them.

Lastly, Michael also requested that I obtain contact information from groups in our area to ~~add~~ *provide to region* ~~onto the BMLT~~. I responded to this by telling him that I would be happy to bring this up at area but that it would ultimately be up to the groups to decide if they want to provide this information or not.

Michael responded by saying the following:

If it needs to be discussed, the contact info, is for verification of meeting changes only... Not for collecting any long-term group contact...

These change documents are not published online, only emailed to Katie and Wayne. Contact info for schedule changes or online schedule changes, will be mandatory...

Essentially, region is telling us that they are requiring contact information so that they can verify any changes that I make on the BMLT with the groups themselves. This contact information will not be made public in anyway. The only purpose of this is so that region can contact a group member to verify the accuracy of changes that I make to the World and Regional Meeting List information.

I did construct a blank excel sheet for GSRs to provide contact information so that I can provide it to region. From the way I see it, it is still up to the groups if they participate in this. With that being said, I do strongly encourage groups to provide this information. I will be unable to ensure that region will implement changes onto their list and app if they are not able to call and verify changes. I personally like the idea of region double-checking the accuracy of changes that I make with members of the group so that if I do make an error it can be noted and fixed immediately.


