We'll also be addressing issues experienced at the last convention, including A/V issues, size of the hospitality suite, extra chairs in workshop rooms, etc.

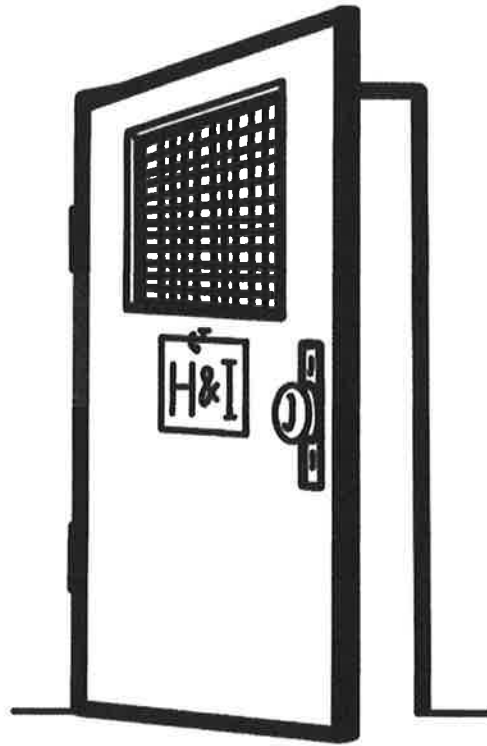

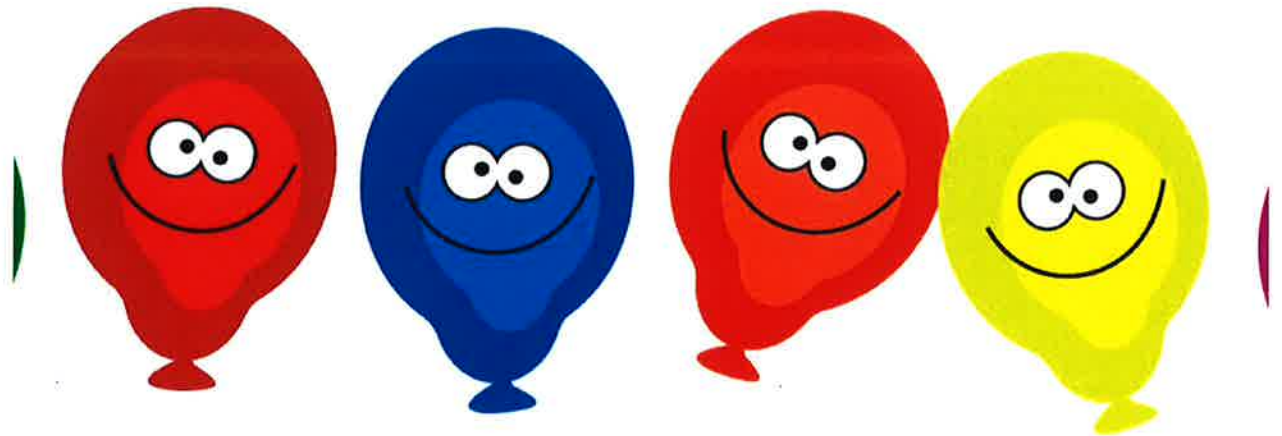
