Previous meeting minutes accepted.

Reports:

- Chair Report (verbal): ASC meeting went well last month. We are two months
 away from the convention. Despite barriers and challenges, we've been successful in
 preparing for the event. We need to start finalizing the details Everyone can provide
 ideas for the Saturday Brunch. We have the brunch menu for review, and to decide
 what to serve.
 - Questions/Discussion:
 - Brunch menu selection suggestion to put menu in the chat for the committee members to review.
- Treasurer's Report (attached): Break-down of expenses from last F&E event provided.
 - o Questions/Discussion:
 - None
- Subcommittee Reports:
 - A&G (attached): The Chair obtained 3 bids for the Convention banner. Most affordable was Aztec's Printing for \$220. Aztec's selected. The Chair is waiting for printing needed from other committees so that cost included in A&G budget.
 - o Questions/Discussion:
 - Should A&G take care of the Information Committee needs?

- Yes. There needs to be convention information staffed at the convention.
- · Will any additional brochures or flyers need to be printed?
 - Basic information needs to be printed for upcoming events.
- A&G will also need to obtain copies of the readings for the meetings.
 - Programming chair has the list from last year and will coordinate with A&G chair. Programming will need declaring statement, activity times, questions/statements for the press.
- Tickets for brunch, comedy show, dance, and spiritual breakfast? Do they need to be printed?
 - Use colored system arm bands. F&E Co-Chair currently has green bands available. Need a count of how many bands we have.
 - Recommendations to use tickets for activities to avoid people attempting multiple use.
 - Suggest having tickets at the door.
 - Tickets are more convenient than bands.
 - Use bands for the dance.
 - A&G to print tickets for brunch, spiritual breakfast, and comedy show.
 - Green armbands for the dance (F&E Co-Chair has the bands)
 - 50 for Spiritual Breakfast
 - 150 Brunch
 - 200 Comedy Show
 - If we sell out of tickets we will charge at the door
- H&H (verbal): The Committee did a walk through. Discussed the Convention Center selling items in area reserved by SWACNA XV. The liaison reported it shouldn't be a problem. They will relocate their vendor. A chair count is needed for the rooms for brunch and decide on the menu. The hospitality room is small. \$300 budget should be good for remaining needs.

123 rooms total - 94 rooms blocked as of 12/28/23 and 29 left.

3 rooms left for staff (added by Kia).

35 tables available – 4 for merchandise, 2 for photography, 2 for silent auction, 1-2 for taping.

If we want the chairs set up we need to provide a count.

- Questions/Discussion:
 - Shipyard room H&H room
 - Wilmington Hall suggested for Saturday Brunch
 - We were previously told we couldn't have the Christina room. During walkthrough.
 - Can you get an area for silent auction?
 - Yes. 2 tables will be reserved (see above)
 - Conference room needed for Treasurer and Co-Treasurer to complete counts safely.
 - · Where will Merchandise store their items?
 - Shipley room
 - How does the Convention body get the discounted room rate?
 - Kia can send the link
- Merchandise (verbal): Obtained bids for printing of merchandise from Al's at \$19.50 per shirt for long sleeve t-shirt, and Noor's Inc. at \$12-15 depending on the size, and whether we select long or short sleeve.

Vendors who would like to sell merchandise at the convention – 1) Living Clean Jewelry at 25% of proceeds. 2) Golden Touch Designs jewelry at 25% of proceeds.

- 3) Sew Sew World Embroidery at 25% of proceeds, and 4) Décor by Laurie Specialty items at 25% proceeds.
- o Questions/Discussion:
 - Sew Sew world is doing our registration packages.
 - · The treasurer will need total cost.
 - The Merchandise Chair will provide at next meeting.
 - · How many venders are needed to sell merchandise?
 - 6 vendors
 - There will be no vender selling what Merchandise is selling (Merchandise, 2 jewelry, embroidery, specialty items, taping)
 Merchandise will ask other vendors not to sell shirts, sweatshirts, etc. sold by the committee.
 - Have we decided on whether to charge a % or flat rate per table(s)?
 - Merchandise Committee decides what to charge.
 - At past conventions and other area conventions, venders are allowed to sell merchandise on Saturday.
- Registration (attached): A total of 458 registrations to date
 - o Questions/Discussion:
 - The treasurer posted the artwork on facebook with prices for full registration package. Immediate responses received for full registration packages.
 - Previously convention packing is done on Thursday night but will not be needed this time. Sew Sew included packaging in bid accepted by the committee.
- Operations (attached): Will need additional help with upcoming events. The chair will get shirts for the committee.
 - o Questions/Discussion:
 - None
- F&E Report (verbal): 2 proposals for the DJ, and photographer.

DJ bids - \$1400 for the weekend from DJ Master Rob. \$1200 for the weekend for DJ Rock.

Photographer bids - Buddy at 25% of proceeds; waiting for proposal from Linwood.

- Questions/Discussion:
 - Do both photographers have the 360 option? If not, can we request it?
 - It is not listed on the proposal.
 - Question about the fairness of DJ bids.
 - Discussion was held with the Convention Committee prior to acceptance of bids.
- Programming (verbal): all programming is complete for remaining events and the convention.
 - o Questions/Discussion:
 - Who has the conversation with AV?
 - Programming will work with AV
 - Will Programming be ordering the case of Basic Texts for give-away?
 - Provide the cost to the Treasurer.
 - What about the Treasure Chest? Do we have one?
 - There is not one in storage per Merchandise.
 - Silver pieces from Golden Touch Designs given each year. Will add to treasure chest

- Who will be collecting the collective clean time for the main event, Registration?
 - Yes
- What about giving out a basic text in each workshop to the person with the least amount of clean time?
- H&H and Programming will collaborate with the person with the most clean time pass to the person with the least clean time (Passing the Torch).
 - Open the meeting after brunch.
 - Programming suggests passing the torch after the clean time count down in the evening.

- Raffle for flat screen H&H will consider changing the date to try to sell more tickets. So far ticket sells
 have not offset the cost.




