Since this is a 24 hour event Unity and Activities is requesting additional funding from the area in the amount of ~~\$1,000~~*



Treasurer's Report: August 2019

Submitted September 15, 2019

Good afternoon. The Area Co-Chair and I met on Saturday, Sept 14th to conduct the last of the financial audits – SWACNA XIII, which was never audited. Unfortunately, we didn't have enough documentation to complete the audit. While there were bank statements and an accounting of overall costs, what we observed is that there is a need for more detailed reporting of subcommittee expenses and income.

One example of this is food sales at fundraising events. While overall food and beverage costs, along with income generated, were reported, there were no specifics of how many platters were sold, a la carte items, drinks, free platters for newcomers, etc. This level of detail would better help the Convention Body understand its expenses and income so that can plan their events accordingly, and it will help with the audit at the end of the Convention cycle. It also helps assure that the correct amount of money is in the cash register at the end of the event. Merchandise is another opportunity to break down costs – such as the number of short sleeve t-shirts in a specific design, long-sleeve shirts, sizes, etc. Receipts and itemized reporting will help put controls into place that both reduce the chance for theft and increase the ability for accurate planning, ordering and sales.

Many of SWACNA XIV's subcommittees continued using receipt books from SWACNA XIII, which makes it difficult to audit the books properly because those receipt books are currently in use. We recommended that each convention start with new receipt books so that the old books can be included with the paperwork of the correct convention for recording and audit purposes.

Aaron and I sat with the Convention Body during their meeting and shared our findings and suggestions. The Body was very receptive and has already begun generating ideas for how to implement controls going forward with SWACNA XIV, *including using the square for cash transactions.*

Other than the Convention Body audit, our website has been renewed for another year. The M&T Bank website has been down for the past two days, so I haven't been able to access our bank statement or the literature bank statement this month yet. I'll continue trying to login so I can balance our checkbook before next month's ASCM.
