Public Relations Subcommittee met today. We meet right here in this room at 4pm right before Area Service Meeting. SWANA Public Relations info table was set up at 2 events last month. We are still in need of people to be available to sit at the table for these events. I will be passing around a sign-up sheet for people that are willing to be called and asked if they are available. We always ask that if anyone hears of any events that you believe Narcotics Anonymous should be present at that you get in touch with me at the number listed above. After doing the many events for Public Relations for over a year that I have been the subcommittee chair, I have seen the need to purchase a tablecloth with the Narcotics Anonymous name and logo much like the banner that I had made for the table. I will be submitting a motion for this tablecloth in the form of a request for \$145. I feel that this will make our table look more put together and therefore attract more people to come over and ask what NA is all about. The banner is bulky and hard to hang at most events. I have researched pricing and have found the price that I mentioned above to be above and beyond reasonable.

I have spoken at length with Gateway Outdoor Advertising about pricing for our ideas to get our name, hotline number and website info out into the community so that we can reach more people with our message. I had previously misread the prices for the quotes but I now have definitive pricing along with what our non-profit discount would be. I am presenting 2 motions today for bus wraps and also resubmitting the option to do inside bus info. The non-profit discount is a choice between by one bus get one free OR buy one month get one

month free. The difference is the amount of area that we would cover or the length of time the message would run. In my opinion, either one is comprable.

I attended Regional Committee Meeting last month down in Baltimore. I was excited to be a part of a Regional Public Relations Committee meeting with 9 people in attendance. Our Regional PR Chair-Craig R. is motivating our entire region and has big ideas and plans to be facilitated by our members to further educate NA members and non-members alike about what our message is. It was also encouraging to see other Subcommittee Chairs from our Area at Regional as well, noting that it is our Area's policy for anyone that holds a position at the Area Service level be present at Regional Committee Meeting every other month. I am interested in carpooling to next Regional which will be Sat. Nov. 10th at 10am in Baltimore at the Regional Service Center.
