Meeting lists were sent on July 13th, 2022, to Academy Printing at a cost of \$97.40 which was paid by the Area Treasurer. On July 15th, 2022, the subcommittee received an email from the Free State Region that an update was made to Be At Your Best, changing the time of the meeting from 9:00pm to 7:30pm. As the lists have already been sent to print and picked up it is not possible for it to be changed on the paper meeting list until next month. The BMLT and website reflect the change in time for this meeting. On July 6, 2022 the SWANA website email address received a message from the Free State Region about updates to their BMLT. All of the information for our area's meetings were confirmed and the region updated their BMLT information and their website so that it showed the proper information for the SWANA meetings. Hopefully this update will also be sent to world soon so that it will be updated as well. The subcommittee has been made aware that many of our meetings are listed incorrectly on the Narcotics Anonymous World meeting app. On July 16th, 2022, Rebecca S went through all of the meetings on the app and put in corrections for those that were listed incorrectly. We have repeatedly emailed NAWS about the discrepancies and incorrect information on the app but have received no response previously. 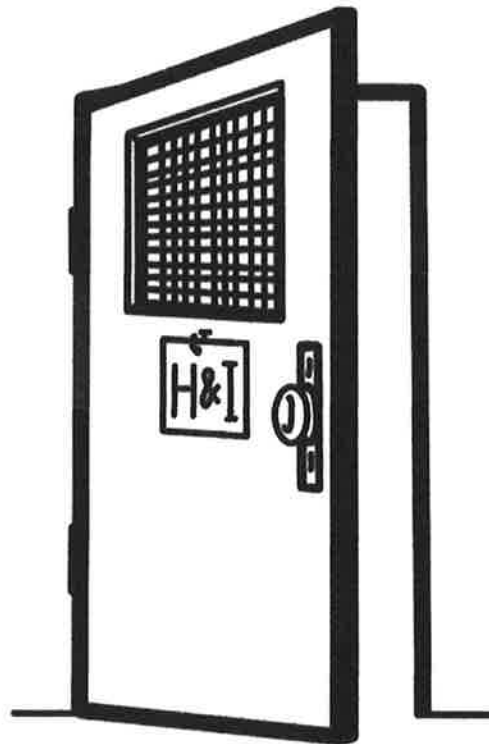
